<b>Project goals</b>	Carried out in collaboration with the University of Florence Department of Architecture as part of A.Vast – Across Local Boundaries cross-departmental research team, the main aim of the project is to understand the forms and outcomes of vast-area regional conflicts, with explicit reference to the institutional framework of the “new” metropolitan city level of government, in view of promoting a “metropolitan culture” and a system of governance based on inclusion, integration and regional cohesion. The project is funded as part of the competition for university strategic projects proposed by researchers on short-term contracts.
